1. Housing Department

SUBJECT: Second Substantial Amendment to the 2023-24 Annual Action Plan. (10 minutes)

RECOMMENDATION: The Community Services, Public Safety, Housing & Development Committee recommends that the City Council:

1. Conduct a public hearing and receive comments related to the Substantial Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan;
2. Approve a Substantial Amendment to the 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan, reallocating Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Program funds;
3. Authorize the City Manager and his designees, to execute the required applications, certifications, and other pertinent documents for the submission of the Amendment to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development;
4. Authorize the City Manager and his designees, to execute the appropriate agreements with subrecipients, and to adjust any of the funding activities, not to exceed ten percent, if the programs require more or less funding to meet their objectives; and
5. Authorize the City Manager and his designees, to appropriate, HOME Investment Partnership Program (Fund 202) and Community Development Block Grant (Fund 201) funds to the proposed activities identified in this staff report.

Emilio Ramirez, Housing Director, was available to answer the committee's questions. No public comments were received. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

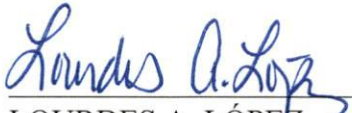
