Alexander Hamilton, Fire Chief presented and answered the Committee's questions. No public comments were received. Discussion ensued among the Council and staff.

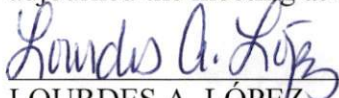
