3. Commissioner Cynthia Gonzalez had the opportunity to participate as a scoring Attorney for the Mock Trial. The Junior High students will be participating next week.

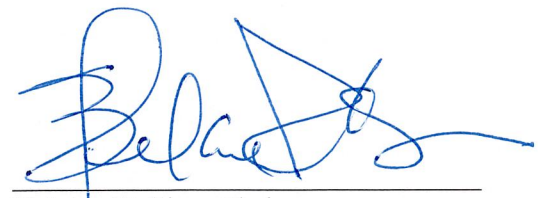
G. ITEMS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION
