**PROPOSED INITIATIVE AMENDING THE CIRCULATION
ELEMENT AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT ELEMENT
OF THE OXNARD 2020 GENERAL PLAN**

Guest Speaker: Richard Francis, Attorney at Law

If this initiative is passed by the voters, the Oxnard City Council would amend portions of the Circulation Element and Growth Management Element of the Oxnard 2020 General Plan. The amendments would prohibit the City Council or Planning Commission from granting discretionary permits for a residential development of five units or greater, or for a project of commercial, industrial or retail development of 5,000 square feet or greater, unless the traffic at every intersection within a five mile radius of the proposed project would operate at a level of service C or better, as defined in the initiative, at the time of completion of the project. Any discretionary permits for such projects that deviate from such standard are to be approved by the voters of Oxnard. The initiative further provides for procedures to amend the Circulation Element or other 2020 General Plan amendments set forth in the initiative by a vote of the duly registered electorate of Oxnard. This voter approval requirement is subject to certain limitations and exceptions as set forth in the initiative. The above statement is an impartial analysis provided by City Attorney, Gary L. Gillig.
