E. NEIGHBORHOOD CHAIR REPORTS

Joe Avelar, Lemonwood: Lemonwood had their annual clean up on October 8, 2016. Joe Avelar and his vice chair along with Rebecca Guevara from Environmental Resources. They collected 4.4 tons of electronics. They want to order a fifth dumpster next year and have residents put in their own electronics. He informed the City manager Greg Nyhoff that the flood canal in his neighborhood was in dire need of a clean up. Lemonwood will have their election meeting on February 2, 2017.

Herb Smith, Sierra Linda: He mentioned they had a meeting on November 17, 2016 and had the Fire Department come and the topic was sidewalk CPR. Herb recommended that all the neighborhoods invite the Fire Department to present the sidewalk CPR. He thanked firefighters Brandon Taylor, Gino Amparon and Cesar Paz. Leo Ovalle representative from the Parks Department also spoke regarding future improvements for Sierra Linda Park. He thanked Officer Ordelheide for also attending the meeting.

Alice Madrid, Bartolo Square North: She informed the INCO that the Wilson Senior Center kitchen has been fully remodeled. The Wilson Senior Center entered a float and received 2nd place in the 2016 Annual Christmas Parade.

Steve Fleischer, Wilson: He read a flyer regarding the 23rd Annual Christmas Tree Lane which will be taking place on December 11th through December 26th from 6 – 10 pm. He gave safety tips and mentioned the police will be out patrolling and no vendors after dark will be permitted.

Nancy Rahn, Blackstock North: Thanked people who took people to go vote. Also mentioned most of the political signs have been picked up.

Aaron Greer, Windsor North: Despite the fire at the Riverridge Golf Club, Windsor North N.C. was able to have their meeting moved to the Sunrise Room. Repairs are in progress for the burned part of the building. They will have their annual election meeting on January 12, 2017.

Jackie Tedeschi, Southbank: Thanked Southbank residents for agreeing to having various meetings throughout the year.

Len Shulman, Carriage Square: Announced that Carriage Square now has 231 Neighbors on Nextdoor.com. January 19, 2017 the Fire Department come out as a guest speaker. Len mentioned that INCO made a motion to have the mandatory fliers to each household removed from the bylaws and city council approved it. Len said it was an honor to be the INCO Chairman and thanked the Executive Board Committee. INCO Is an exclusive club and to become a

member one must be elected chairperson of their neighborhood. The elected chairperson should attend the INCO meetings to report both the good and the bad to their council. Len find it a shame that two thirds of members can not attend the INCO meetings and that leaves their neighborhood unrepresented. Working together, the INCO could be the best informed and most powerful organization in the City.
