A. ROLL CALL/POSTING OF AGENDA

At 5:30 p.m. the regular meeting of the Oxnard Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission convened in the Council Chambers. Chairman Cobb, Vice Chairman Postel and Commissioners Poirier, Moraga and Whitecomb were present. Commissioners Barber and Ocampo were excused. The Recording Secretary stated that the agenda was posted on Thursday at 5:45 p.m. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States.
