A. ROLL CALL/POSTING OF THE AGENDA

At 6:14PM, the special meeting of the Oxnard Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Commission convened in the South Oxnard Youth Center. C. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Joe Avelar and Scotty Combs talked about Lemonwood Park, and possibly converting the tennis court to basketball courts. The tennis courts don't get much use as is. The softball field is used by the school. They said they'd consider including futsal in the tennis courts as well. They announced a Lemonwood Neighborhood Council meeting on March 1. They's also like more lights in Lemonwood Park.
