A. ROLL CALL/POSTING OF THE AGENDA

At 6:11PM, the special meeting of the Oxnard Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Commission convened in the South Oxnard Youth Center. Chair Poirier, Vice Chair Whitecomb and Commissioners Ocampo, Guerra, Nash, and Teran were present. Commissioner Tejada was excused. Staff members present were: Assistant City Manager Jesús Nava and Interim Project Manager Eric Humel.

E. NEW BUSINESS

1. **SUBJECT:** Resident Task Forces Reports
Bike/Ped Task Force discussed promoting a Bike to Work Day, and ultimately, a Ciclovía in downtown Oxnard. Discussion included revisiting the Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan, and reaching out to the City Traffic Engineer. Noted were needed updates because of the OCCTIP, Downtown Vision Plan, and Wagon Wheel development.
2. **SUBJECT:** Workshop with Residents & Staff: PRCSC Goals for 2018 Parks & Recreation Master Plan
Discussion was wide-ranging regarding possible considerations during the Master Plan process: beach access and usage, Oxnard Transit Center, GHG reduction, Santa Clara River Trail, Bike Master Plan, Fiber Master Plan, grant writing, staffing within the Parks Division, opportunity for improving relationships between City and residents through the Master Plan process.
