A. ROLL CALL / POSTING OF AGENDA

1. SUBJECT: Approval of Minutes.

Cultural and Community Services Department

1. SUBJECT: Oxnard School District After School Education and Safety Grant.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Community Services Committee recommend that City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement (A-8138) with the Oxnard School District (OSD) for the City to receive an amount not to exceed \$2,100,000 for operating after school programs, and not to exceed \$50,000 in "Additional Services."

The Interim Cultural and Community Services Director gave a report. Public comments were received from Pat Brown. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

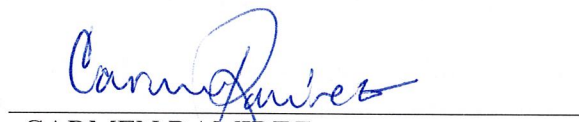
