A. ROLL CALL / POSTING OF AGENDA

C. REPORTS

Cultural and Community Services Department

1. SUBJECT: Response to Grand Jury Report Titled "Youth Sports and Public Liability."  
RECOMMENDATION: That the Community Services Committee recommends that the Mayor, the City Manager, and the Cultural and Community Services Director respond, on behalf of the City Council, to the Grand Jury Report titled "Youth Sports and Public Liability Report" dated April 14, 2019, in the form included as Attachment B.

2. SUBJECT: Authorization to Disburse and Appropriate Revenue from the Public Art Fund.  
RECOMMENDATION: That the Community Services Committee recommend the City Council:
  1. Authorize the disbursement of Public Art Fund revenues in the amount of \$170,000 for the purpose of providing funding for a range of cultural activities by various cultural arts organizations and artists; and
  2. Approve a one-time appropriation of revenue in the amount of \$170,000 from the Public Art Fund.

The Recreation Coordinator gave a report. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

*It was moved by Member Madrigal, seconded by Member Basua, to approve the recommended action as presented. VOTE: Basua, Madrigal, and Ramirez voted in favor; the motion carried 3-0.*
