A. ROLL CALL, POSTING OF AGENDA, FLAG SALUTE

At 2:03 p.m., Chair MacDonald called to order the regular meeting of the Oxnard City Council Public Safety Committee in the City Hall Council Chambers at 305 W. Third Street, Oxnard, California. The City Clerk called the roll and announced the posting of the agenda. Member Vianey Lopez and Chair Bryan MacDonald were present; Member Carmen Ramirez was absent.

Staff members present were Alexander Nguyen, City Manager; Jason Zaragoza, Deputy City Attorney; Delia Campbell, Police Financial Services Manager; Eric Sonstegard, Assistant Police Chief; Darwin Base, Fire Chief; Scott Whitney, Police Chief; and Michelle Ascencion, City Clerk.

B. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA (None received.)

C. CONSENT AGENDA

City Clerk Department

1. SUBJECT: Approval of Minutes.
RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee approve the minutes of the October 8, 2019 regular meeting as presented.

VOTE: Lopez and MacDonald voted in favor of approval; the minutes were approved 2-0.

D. REPORTS

Police Department

1. SUBJECT: Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund.
RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee recommends that City Council:
 1. Recognize \$318,079 in grant revenue from the State Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF) for Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) Program;
 2. Approve a budget appropriation in the amount of \$318,079 for Body Worn Camera Storage Fees; and
 3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer or designee to approve additional budget appropriations if awarded.

The Police Financial Services Manager gave a report.

It was moved by Member Lopez, seconded by Chair MacDonald, to approve the recommended action as presented. VOTE: Lopez and MacDonald voted in favor; the motion carried 2-0.

2. SUBJECT: Federal and State Asset Forfeiture Funds.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee recommends that the City Council approves a budget appropriation in the amount of \$320,786 for the use of Federal (\$207,786) and State (\$113,000) asset forfeiture funds allocated to the City of Oxnard Police Department. The funds will be used for training and equipment purchases not normally associated with general fund expenditures.

The Police Financial Services Manager gave a report. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

VOTE: Lopez and MacDonald voted in favor; the recommended action was approved 2-0.

Fire Department3. SUBJECT: FY 18 Assistance to Firefighters Grant.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee recommend the City Council adopts a resolution authorizing:

1. Authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute \$291,818.18 in grant funds from the Fiscal Year (FY) 18 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) to educate and license three firefighters as paramedics;
2. Authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute grant agreements and appropriate funds upon notification of grant award;
3. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer or designee to submit financial reports and grant claims and approve administrative budget appropriation for the use of AFG funds upon award; and
4. Authorize Fire Chief or designee to submit all program related progress or status reports.

The Fire Chief gave a report. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

VOTE: Lopez and MacDonald voted in favor; the recommended action was approved 2-0.

SUBJECT: Purchase of Police Department Vehicles, Motorcycles, and Off-Road Vehicles. (10/5/5)

RECOMMENDATION

That the Public Safety Committee recommend City Council:

1. Approve and authorize the Mayor to execute six (6) Purchase Orders for a total amount of \$595,829.21, for a total of twelve (12) public safety vehicle purchases with accessories and equipment:
 - a) Seven (7) patrol vehicles for a cost of \$349,724.01 from National Auto Fleet Group;
 - b) Three (3) police motorcycles for a cost of \$94,881.54 from Long Beach BMW Motorcycles;
 - c) One (1) Ford Transit Cargo Van for a cost of \$69,321.51 from National Auto Fleet Group;
 - d) One (1) 4x4 pick-up for a cost of \$48,787.86 from National Auto Fleet Group;
 - e) Police Radios for a cost of \$12,681.29 from Telecom, Inc.;
 - f) Mobile Dispatch Computers for a cost of \$20,433.00 from PCS Mobile.
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute a budget appropriation adjustment in the amount of \$161,388.

BACKGROUND

Patrol Vehicles

The Police Department's patrol vehicle fleet currently consists of eighty-one (81) "black and white" units. Forty-nine (49) of these are Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles, six (6) are Chevrolet Caprices, twenty-two (22) are Ford Crown Victorias, three (3) are Chevrolet Tahoes, and one (1) Ford F150 4x4 short-bed pickup truck.

The Police Department's patrol fleet is recovering from the impacts of several years of scaled back and deferred purchases. In FY 16-17, a focused effort began to improve the overall health of the patrol fleet. Prior, the Department's patrol fleet consisted of a large percentage of patrol vehicles that were well past the City of Oxnard Vehicle Purchasing Guidelines recommended service life of 100,000 miles. Once patrol vehicles surpass the recommended 100,000 mark, repair costs increase as reliability decreases. Currently there are five (5) patrol vehicles with odometer readings above 100,000 miles and five (5) vehicles with mileage above 90,000 that need replacement. Additionally, there are two (2) patrol vehicles which have surpassed 80,000 miles.

In order to maintain a safe and dependable patrol vehicle fleet, it is critical that the Police Department maintains a comprehensive vehicle replacement plan. In FY 16-17, Fleet Services recommended that a minimum of twelve (12) police patrol vehicles be added to the fleet every fiscal year, for three (3) consecutive

fiscal years. This request for replacement patrol vehicles is necessary to stabilize and maintain the health of the patrol vehicle fleet.

The last purchase of thirteen (13) patrol vehicles was authorized by the City Council on June 5, 2018. The table below outlines the Three-Year Patrol Vehicle Replacement Schedule.

Decommissioned Vehicles

Vehicles at end of recommended service mileage

After considerable vehicle platform research and comparisons during 2015 and 2016, the Police Department selected the Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicle, which has become a principal vehicle in law enforcement nationwide.

The Police Department recommends a purchase of seven (7) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles. These new Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles will replace the five (5) Ford Crown Victorias with mileage above 100,000, and two (2) Ford Crown Victorias with mileage above 90,000.

In addition, the Police Department recommends a purchase of one (1) Ford F150 4x4 Truck. The Ford F150 4x4 Truck will be assigned to the Homeless Liaison Officer (HLO) Unit due to an increase in their staffing and the need for a utility truck based on their duties. The vehicle can navigate hard to reach off-road locations frequented by transients that are not suitable for other police units, such as dirt fields or other off-highway locations overgrown with vegetation, and areas around bridge abutments, beaches, canals and small waterways. The bed and corresponding lift gate will be used to transport and remove property, debris and other items, such as shopping carts, from locations and encampments served by the HLO's. The extra cab can be utilized to transport other personnel as well as arrestees.

The total cost of the seven (7) Ford Police Interceptors is \$349,724.01

The total cost of the one (1) Ford F150 4x4 Truck is \$48,787.86

Police Motorcycles

The Police Department's Traffic Unit consists of fourteen (14) sworn personnel. Typically, police motorcycles are removed from service when they exceed 55,000 miles; once they reach this mileage, reliability decreases as maintenance costs climb. Two (2) have exceeded 90,000 miles.

The Police Department currently has a total of fourteen (14) motorcycles in its inventory. Though the ratio is one motorcycle to each Traffic Unit officer, the lack of reserve/spare motorcycles deprives the Traffic Unit officers of the use of a motorcycle when service or repairs are being performed. There have been several occasions during recent months when more than one Traffic Unit officer was without a motorcycle for a significant period. A set-aside of older, high-mileage motorcycles strictly for training purposes is also necessary, as this reduces wear and tear on service motorcycles. The following table depicts the current inventory, all of which are assigned to officers:

The Police Department evaluated motorcycle types to determine the model best suited for police field operations. The most important factors that were considered were rider safety, performance (acceleration, top speed, handling and braking), durability, and maintenance. In 2018, the Michigan State Police Vehicle Evaluation Staff conducted testing on the Harley Davidson FLHTP, Harley Davidson FLHP, BMW R1200 RTP, BMW F 750 GS-P, BMW F 850 GS-P, and Yamaha FJR 1300AP. The BMW R1200 RTP was rated as a top performer in all categories. Another determining factor was that the mechanics at Oxnard's Fleet Services are certified in the repair and maintenance of the BMW R1200 RTP motorcycle, which reduces costs. The

ability to repair and perform maintenance in-house reduces the time the motorcycle is down for repair.

The last purchase of four (4) BMW police motorcycles was authorized by the City Council on June 5, 2018.

The Police Department recommends the purchase of three (3) BMW police motorcycles. The three new motorcycles would replace the three (3) highest mileage motorcycles, and each would be assigned to a Traffic Unit officer. Two (2) of the inventory's higher mileage motorcycles would be converted into training motorcycles, and would be used solely for that purpose. One (1) of the higher mileage motorcycles would be held in reserve for use as "spare/pool" motorcycles that would be used while others are being serviced or repaired.

The total cost of the three (3) BMW police motorcycles is \$94,881.54

Support Vehicles

The Police Department maintains a temporary holding facility (jail) where arrested persons are transported and processed before being transferred to the County Jail, located in Ventura. On average, over 450 arrested persons are transferred to the County Jail by the Police Department each month, with as many as five (5) transport runs made per day. The Police Department currently has two booking vans, a 2003 Ford Econoline van with over 227,000 miles and a 2008 Ford Econoline van with over 150,000 miles.

The Police Department recommends the purchase of one (1) Ford Transit Cargo Van. This vehicle will replace the 2003 Ford Econoline van, which currently has over 227,000 miles and has exceeded its recommended service life.

The total cost of the Ford Transit Cargo Van is \$69,321.51

Radios and Mobile Dispatch Computers

The cost to outfit all twelve vehicles with police radios is \$12,681.29.

In addition, the cost to outfit vehicles with Mobile Dispatch Computers (MDCs) is \$20,433.00, which includes the purchase of seven (7) new MDCs with required licensing components. Two (2) MDCs in current use can be reused and installed into the new purchased vehicles. The BMW motorcycles do not require an MDC.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

This agenda item is a routine operational item or does not relate to the four strategic plans adopted by City Council on May 17, 2016.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total cost for all vehicles, including MDCs and police radios, is \$595,829.21.

Partial payment of \$541,892.87 will be funded through a current line of credit with Bank of America for the repayment term of five years with an interest rate of 3.1602%. The remaining balance of \$53,936.34 will be paid for by the Riverpark CFD Fund Balance (Fund 174) to cover the complete cost of one (1) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicle, including police radio and MDC, for its use in that specific patrol area.

In any dispute, NEITHER BUYER NOR PCS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO JOIN OR CONSOLIDATE CLAIMS BY OR AGAINST OTHER CUSTOMERS, OR ARBITRATE OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATE IN ANY CLAIM AS A CLASS REPRESENTATIVE, CLASS MEMBER, OR IN A PRIVATE ATTORNEY GENERAL CAPACITY. If any provision of this arbitration clause is found unenforceable, the unenforceable provision shall be severed and the remaining arbitration terms shall be enforced (but in no case shall there be a class arbitration).

The arbitrator shall be empowered to grant whatever relief would be available in court under law or in equity. Any award of the arbitrator(s) shall be final and binding on each of the parties and may be entered as a judgment in any court of competent jurisdiction. The United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods will not apply to this Agreement. Buyer is responsible for compliance with local laws, if and to the extent local laws are applicable. Both parties to this Agreement specifically agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of, and venue in, the courts in Maricopa County, Arizona in any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement.

13. Export Controls

Recommendation

That the Public Safety Committee recommend City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute (6) Purchase Orders for a total amount of \$595,829.21, for a total of twelve (12) public safety vehicle purchases with accessories and equipment:

1. Seven (7) patrol vehicles for a cost of \$349,724.01 from National Auto Fleet Group;
2. Three (3) police motorcycles for a cost of \$94,881.54 from Long Beach BMW Motorcycles;
3. One (1) booking van for a cost of \$69,321.51 from National Auto Fleet Group;
4. One (1) 4x4 pick-up for a cost of \$48,787.86 from National Auto Fleet Group;
5. Police Radios for a cost of \$12,681.29 from Telecom, Inc.; and
6. Mobile Dispatch Computers for a cost of \$20,433.00 from PCS Mobile.

Patrol Vehicles

- The Police Department's patrol vehicle fleet currently consists of eighty-one (81) "black and white" units.
 - 49 of these are Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles,
 - 6 are Chevrolet Caprices,
 - 22 are Ford Crown Victorias,
 - 3 are Chevrolet Tahoes, and
 - 1 Ford F150 4x4 short-bed pickup truck.
- The Police Department's patrol fleet is recovering from the impacts of several years of scaled back and deferred purchases.
- In order to maintain a safe and dependable patrol vehicle fleet, it is critical that the Police Department maintains a comprehensive vehicle replacement plan
- The last purchase of thirteen (13) patrol vehicles was authorized by the City Council on June 5, 2018. The table below outlines the Three-Year Patrol Vehicle Replacement Schedule.

Patrol Vehicles

- In addition, the Police Department recommends a purchase of one (1) Ford F150 4x4 Truck.
- The Ford F150 4x4 Truck will be assigned to the Homeless Liaison Officer (HLO) Unit due to an increase in their staffing and the need for a utility truck based on their duties.
- The total cost of the seven (7) Ford Police Interceptors is \$349,724.01
- The total cost of the one (1) Ford F150 4x4 Truck is \$48,787.86

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Police Motorcycles

- The Police Department's Traffic Unit consists of fourteen (14) sworn personnel.
- Typically, police motorcycles are removed from service when they exceed 55,000 miles; once they reach this mileage, reliability decreases as maintenance costs climb.
- Two (2) have exceeded 90,000 miles.
- The Police Department currently has a total of fourteen (14) motorcycles in its inventory.

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Police Motorcycles

- The last purchase of four (4) BMW police motorcycles was authorized by the City Council on June 5, 2018.
- The Police Department evaluated motorcycle types to determine the model best suited for police field operations.
- Based on research, the Police Department recommends the purchase of three (3) BMW police motorcycles.
- The total cost of the three (3) BMW police motorcycles is \$94,881.54

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Support Vehicles

- The Police Department maintains a temporary holding facility (jail) where arrested persons are transported and processed before being transferred to the County Jail, located in Ventura.
- On average, over 450 arrested persons are transferred to the County Jail by the Police Department each month, with as many as five (5) transport runs made per day.
- The Police Department currently has two booking vans, a 2003 Ford Econoline van with over 227,000 miles and a 2008 Ford Econoline van with over 150,000 miles.
- The Police Department recommends the purchase of one (1) Ford Transit Cargo Van.
- The total cost of the Ford Transit Cargo Van is \$69,321.51

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Radios and Mobile Dispatch Computers

- The cost to outfit all vehicles with police radios is \$12,681.29.
- In addition, the cost to outfit fourteen (7) vehicles with Mobile Dispatch Computers (MDCs) is \$20,433.00.
- This is for the purchase of seven (7) new MDCs with required licensing components. Two (2) MDCs in current use can be reused and installed into the new purchased vehicles.
- The BMW motorcycles do not require an MDC.

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Financial Impact

- The total cost for all vehicles, including MDCs and police radios, is \$595,829.21
- Partial payment of \$541,892.87 will be funded through a current line of credit with Bank of America for the repayment term of five years with an interest rate of 3.1602%
- The remaining balance of \$53,936.34 will be paid for by the Riverpark CFD Fund Balance (Fund 174) to cover the complete cost of one (1) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicle, including police radio and MDC, for its use in that specific patrol area.
