SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Extension of CalVIP Grant 2018-2020. (5/5/5)

RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee recommend that City Council adopts a resolution:

1. Authorizing the City Manager to approve an extension for use of the \$500,000 in Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) grant funding for the 2018-2020 California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) project to reduce gang and youth violence through direct intervention, youth employment, and community engagement;
2. Authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a grant agreement for funding from the State of California/BSCC for the CalVIP Program from May 1, 2020 to December 31, 2021;
3. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer or designee to submit financial reports and grant claims; and
4. Authorizing the Oxnard Police Department/Office of Youth Safety to submit non-financial reports.

SUBJECT: Resolution Approving of CalVIP Grant 2020-2023. (5/5/5)

RECOMMENDATION: That the Public Safety Committee recommend the City Council adopt a resolution:

1. Authorizing the City Manager to approve the grant application of \$500,000 in Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) grant funding for the 2020-2023 California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) project to be used for the Drag Racing Against Gangs and Graffiti (DRAGG) after school program offering high school youth mentorship, career exploration, employment preparation, social emotional learning, workplace soft skills, community engagement, and scholarships to its participants for continuing education, The grant requires a dollar-for-dollar match – cash, in-kind, or combination thereof – of the total grant award. The required match of up to \$500,000 will come from various in-kind sources;
2. Authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a grant agreement for funding from the State of California/BSCC for the CalVIP Program from October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2023;
3. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer or designee to submit financial reports and grant claims; and
4. Authorizing the Oxnard Police Department/Office of Youth Safety to submit non-financial reports.
