1. EMAILING COMMENTS OR REQUESTS TO SPEAK BEFORE THE MEETING

- a. Submit an email to christian.lopez@oxnard.org no later than 1:00pm on the day of the meeting (Please indicate the agenda item number in the subject line). All email correspondence will be forwarded to the Commission on Homelessness prior to the start of the meeting and made part of the legislative record.
- b. Submit a request to speak by no later than 2:00pm on the day of the meeting by emailing the christian.lopez@oxnard.org.

2. PROVIDING PUBLIC COMMENTS DURING THE MEETING VIA CALL-IN OR ZOOM OPTIONS

- a. Speakers shall have up to three minutes to speak.

- c. Public comments on items not on the agenda shall be taken at the beginning of the meeting. If there are more speakers than can be accommodated during thirty minutes, additional speakers who will be given an opportunity to speak at the end of the meeting. After all public speakers have been given an opportunity to speak, the public comment period shall be held open for three minutes to allow additional speakers to register or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. During this three-minute time period, the Commission on Homelessness or staff may briefly respond to comments on items not appearing on the agenda.



d. Public comments on items on the agenda shall be taken following the announcement of the item. After all public speakers have been given an opportunity to speak on an agenda item, the public comment period shall be held open for three minutes to allow additional speakers to register or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. During this three-minute time period, the Commission on Homelessness or staff may discuss the item being considered.
