2. PROVIDING PUBLIC COMMENTS DURING THE MEETING VIA CALL-IN OR ZOOM OPTIONS

- a. Speakers shall have up to three minutes to speak.

If there are more speakers than

can be accommodated during thirty minutes, additional speakers who will be given an opportunity to speak at the end of the meeting.

- d. Public comments on items on the agenda shall be taken following the announcement of the item. After the public comment period is announced, members of the public shall have three minutes to register or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. During this three minute time period, the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Commission or staff may discuss the item being considered.

- The overall goal is to beautify and clean up local streets and roads, parks, pathways, and other public spaces.
- And to enhance, rehabilitate, restore, or install measures to beautify and improve public spaces

- Call for Projects: December 1, 2021
- Project Application Deadline: February 1, 2022
- Date by when projects must be open to the public: June 30, 2024

- Project needs to be shovel ready to be competitive
- CEQA should be recorded by application date
