B. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

After 30 minutes, if all speakers have not had the opportunity to speak, the remaining speakers will be given an opportunity to speak prior to adjournment of the meeting. The legislative body cannot enter into a detailed discussion or take action on any items presented during public comments at this time. Such items may only be referred to the City Manager/Executive Director/Secretary for administrative action or scheduled on a subsequent agenda for discussion. Persons wishing to speak on public hearing items should do so at the time of the hearing.

2. Housing Department

SUBJECT: Housing Authority Low Rent Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Program Section 8 Budgets for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. (15 minutes)

RECOMMENDATION: That the Community Services, Public Safety, Housing & Development Committee recommend that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Oxnard:

1. Adopt a resolution approving the recommended \$7,352,123 operating budgets for the Low Rent Public Housing Program for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, as presented for each project area, and approve and authorize the use of \$359,597 of unrestricted cash to fund the projected deficit.
2. Adopt a resolution approving the recommended \$30,848,417 operating budget for the Housing Choice Voucher Program Section 8 for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and approve and authorize the use of \$304,238 of unrestricted cash to fund the projected deficit.
