Commissioner Durias shared she attended the Anderson .Paak and the installation for Bishop Lamont Chiles-Hayes.

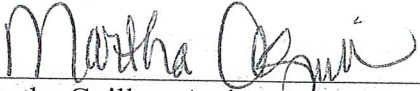
Commissioner Tiffany Lopez shared she also attended the Anderson .Paak and planning to visit the Strawberry Festival.

H. ITEMS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION

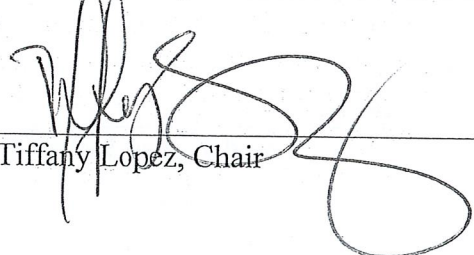
There were no additional future items for consideration.
