A. ROLL CALL, POSTING OF AGENDA, FLAG SALUTE

At 6:45 p.m., Chair MacDonald called to order the regular meeting of the Oxnard City Council Community Services, Public Safety, Housing and Development Committee in the City Hall Council Chambers at 305 W. Third Street, Oxnard, California. Dee Lai, Assistant City Clerk called the roll and announced the posting of the agenda. Chair MacDonald, Member Zaragoza and Member Oscar Madrigal were present in person.

C. CONSENT AGENDA

1. City Clerk Department

SUBJECT: Approval of Minutes.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Community Services, Public Safety, Housing & Development Committee approve the minutes of the November 14, 2023 regular meetings as presented.

D. REPORTS

1. Fire Department

SUBJECT: Ratification of authorization for the Fire Department to submit a regional grant application to the Public Works Alliance EMS Corps, in partnership with California's Employment Development Department (EDD) to provide EMT training to young people in Ventura County (10 minutes).

RECOMMENDATION: The Community Services, Public Safety, Housing & Development Committee recommends that the City Council:

1. Authorizes the Oxnard Fire Department to submit a regional grant application to the Public Works Alliance EMS Corps, in partnership with California's Employment Development Department (EDD) to provide EMT training to young people in Ventura County in the amount of \$2,750,000. There are no matching funds required.
2. Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute the grant agreements if grant funds are awarded to the City;
3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer or designee to submit financial reports and grant claims for the use of match and grant funds and perform all other required financial actions; and
4. Authorize the Fire Chief or designee to submit non-financial reports.

Alex Hamilton, Fire Chief, was available to answer the committee's questions. No public comments were received. Discussion ensued among the Committee and staff.

It was moved by Chair MacDonald, seconded by Member Madrigal, to approve the recommended action as presented. VOTE: Madrigal, Zaragoza, and MacDonald voted in favor. The motion passed 3-0.
