3. SUBJECT: Councilmember is installed. Remarks by Mayor and Councilmembers.

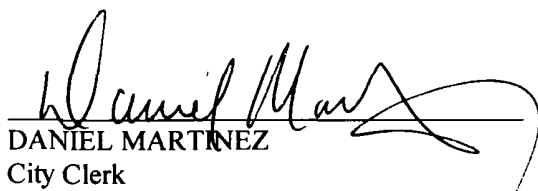
DISCUSSION: Comments were made by all Councilmembers.
