E. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

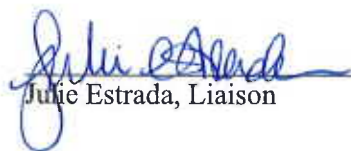
1. Vice Chair Lopez presented information on OPAC events, children's art camp, call for artists, Port Hueneme Library Mural and Friday family art event.
